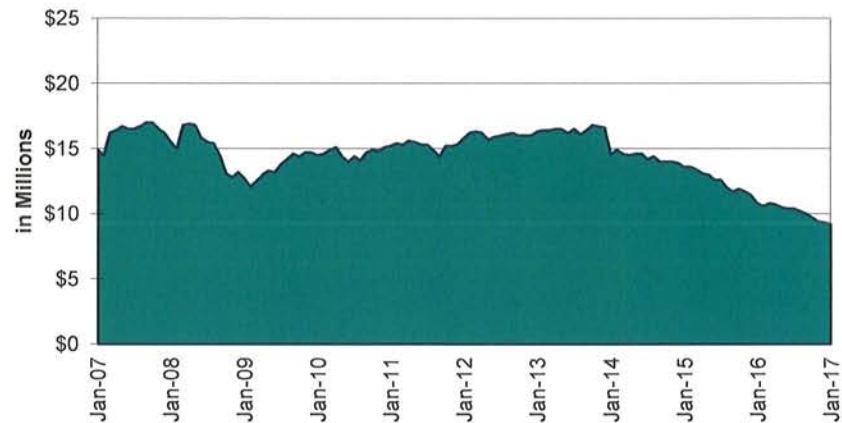
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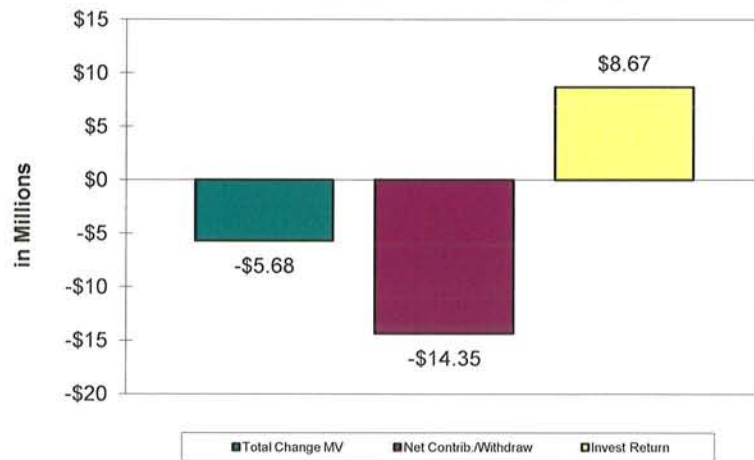

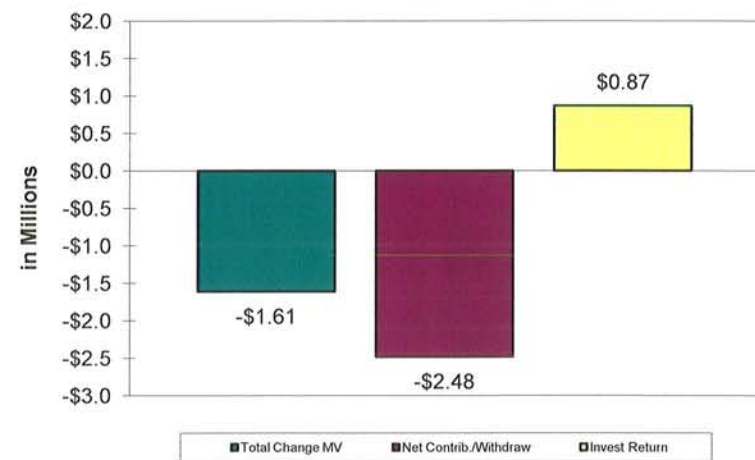

 February 1, 2007 - January 31, 2017

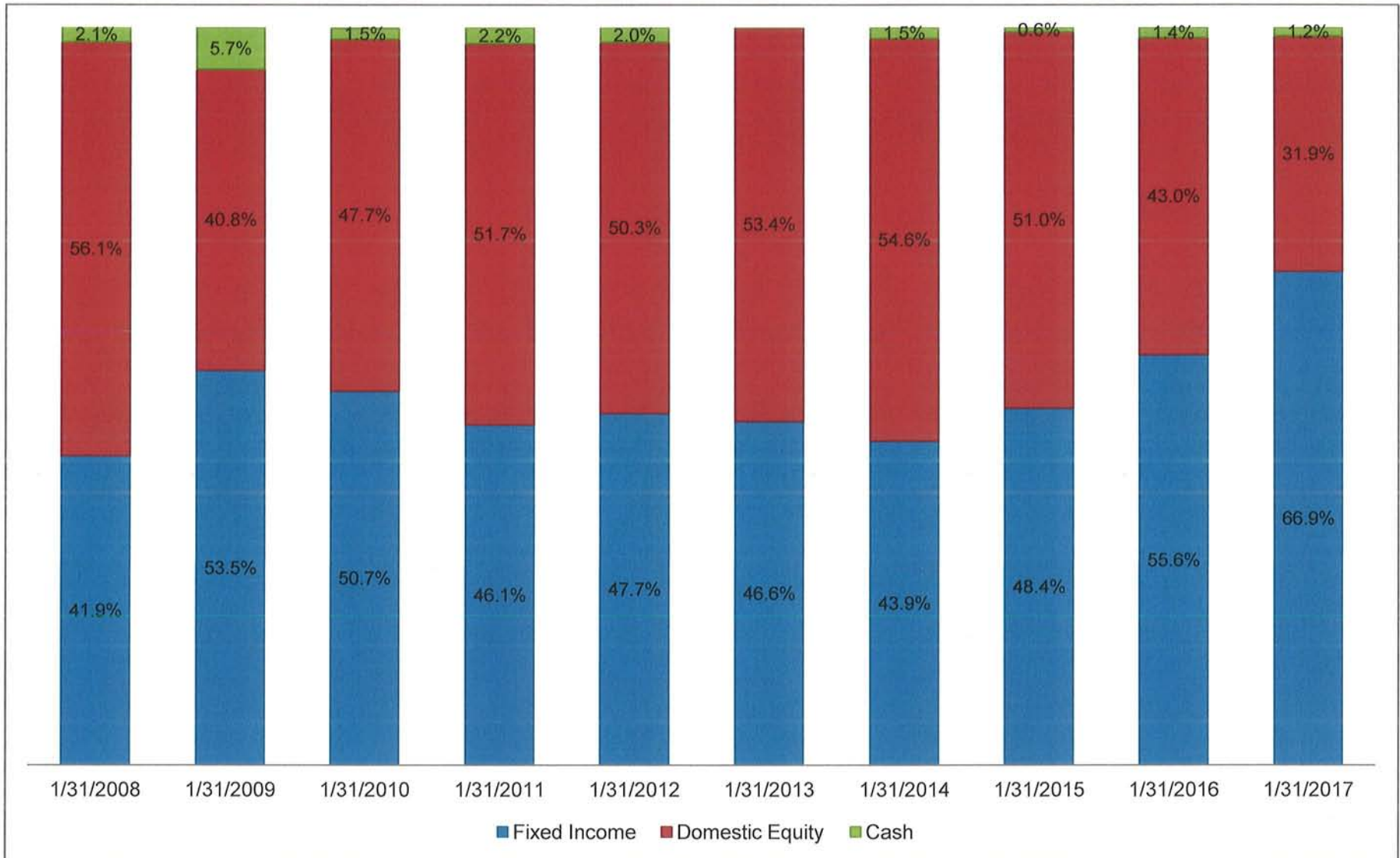


Change in Market Value

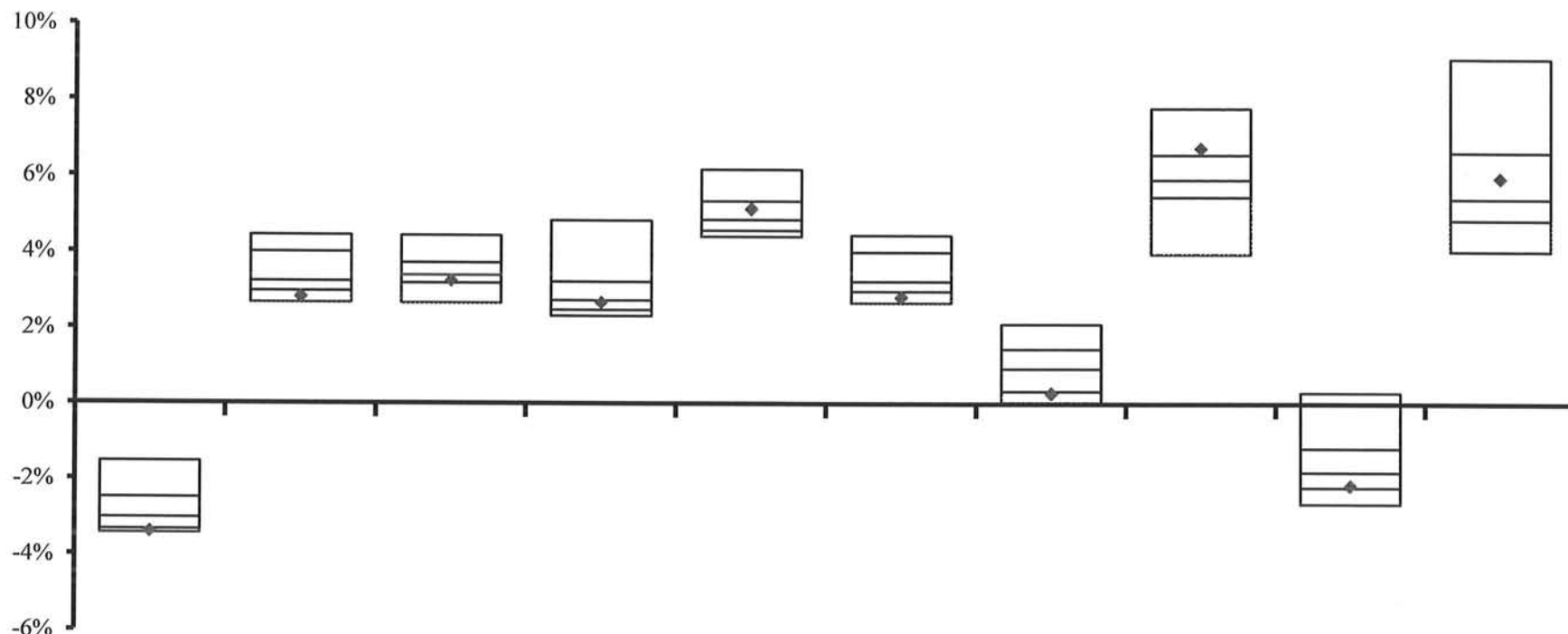

The Manager Correlation Matrix displays the degree to which the returns of one manager varied with those of another manager as measured by the Correlation Coefficient (CC). The CC ranges from -1.0 to 1.0. A CC of 1.0 indicates that the returns of two managers varied in the same direction and amount providing no diversification benefit. A CC of 0.0 indicates that the returns of two managers were unrelated providing a high level of diversification. A CC of -1.0 indicates that the returns of two managers varied in the exact opposite direction and amount providing the highest level of diversification. The correlations are calculated for a period of up to five years. Managers without one year of monthly performance data are excluded. For a manager with greater than one year but less than five years of performance data, the correlation between that manager and another manager is calculated based on that length of performance data, not five years.

Policy Index - an index created by weighting various indices in the same proportion as the portfolio's target allocation. The following indexes are used in creating the Policy Index: S&P 500 for domestic equities, BC Aggregate for fixed income, U.S. 90 Day T-Bills for cash and cash equivalents, NFI – ODCE for real estate, Hueler Stable Value Index for insurance contracts and stable value, EAFE (US Dollars) for international equities, a Global Balanced Index consisting of 60% MSCI World Equity (Inc. US) / 40% BC Global Aggregate for global balanced, and HFRI Fund of Funds for alternatives.

For periods when there was no specified target allocation, Quan-Vest used reasonable judgment in creating a target allocation based on the portfolio's then current allocation. For periods when there was a target yet one of the asset classes had not yet been funded, the target allocation for that asset class was not included in the policy index until that asset class was funded.

Glossary of Terms

Beta - measures the sensitivity of the portfolio's return caused by movements in the assigned benchmark. A Beta of 1.0 implies that the portfolio's return is expected to rise and fall in the same proportion as the benchmark. A Beta less than (greater than) 1.0 implies the portfolio's return is expected to rise and fall to a lesser (greater) extent than the benchmark. Higher Betas indicate higher risk.

Correlation Index (Coeff. Of Determination) - determines the benchmark most closely associated with a portfolio's return as measured by R-Squared. This is a returns-based style indicator which may yield different results than a manager's intended style.

Diversification (R-Squared) - measures the percentage of the portfolio's performance that is explained by the assigned benchmark, indicating how diversified the portfolio is compared to the benchmark. R-Squared can range from 0% to 100% with 100% representing a portfolio that is as diversified as the benchmark. The closer the R-Squared is to 100%, the closer the portfolio is expected to track the benchmark.

Passive Index - is an index created by weighting, on a monthly basis, various indices in the same proportion as the total portfolio's actual asset allocation. The following indexes are used in creating the Passive Index: S&P 500 for domestic equities, BC Aggregate for fixed income, U.S. 90 Day T-Bills for cash and cash equivalents, NFI – ODCE for real estate, Heuler Stable Value Index for insurance contracts and stable value, EAFE (US Dollars) for international equities, a Global Balanced Index consisting of 60% MSCI World Equity (Inc. US) / 40% BC Global Aggregate for global balanced, and HFRI Fund of Funds for alternatives.

Risk Adjusted Return - is a hypothetical rate which assumes the portfolio has the same risk as the market index. It is calculated by multiplying the excess return per unit of risk (Sharpe Ratio) by the risk (Standard Deviation) of the market and then adding back the risk-free rate (90-Day US Treasury Bills).

Return-Based Style Analysis

Determines the benchmark most closely associated with a portfolio's return as measured by R-Squared.

Sharpe Ratio - measures the portfolio's excess return over a risk-free rate (90-day US Treasury Bills) per unit of risk (Standard Deviation). A higher Sharpe Ratio indicates a better return/risk trade-off but does not necessarily indicate a higher return. Holding return steady, a portfolio can generate a high Sharpe Ratio by experiencing low risk. Holding risk steady, a portfolio can generate a high Sharpe Ratio by experiencing high return.

Specific Risk - is the portfolio's unique risk. It is the total risk as measured by Standard Deviation minus the portfolio's return caused by movements in the assigned benchmark as measured by Beta.

Standard Deviation - is an annualized measure of the variability (risk) of the portfolio's return versus its average return over a defined period of time. A higher Standard Deviation indicates higher risk. Returns are expected to be within one Standard Deviation of the portfolio's average return 68% of the time and within two Standard Deviations 95% of the time.

Total Risk vs. Index - the portfolio's risk level versus a benchmark by dividing the portfolio's monthly Standard Deviation by the benchmark's quarterly Standard Deviation. A risk level greater than 100% indicates more risk than the benchmark while a risk level less than 100% indicates less risk than the benchmark.

Tracking Error - measures the Standard Deviation of the portfolio's excess return in relation to the assigned benchmark. The higher the Tracking Error, the greater the likelihood that there will be differences between the portfolio's return and that of the benchmark. Portfolios that are structured similarly (differently) than the benchmark will have lower (higher) Tracking Errors.
