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RETIREE WORK RULES

Dear Retiree:

If you return to covered employment, it is important that you are aware of the following rules and regulations of the Plan:

Suspension of benefits: One month of your pension benefits will be suspended for each month of your unauthorized employment. Unauthorized employment is defined as any month during which you work eight or more days in covered employment.

Notification of beginning unauthorized employment: **Pensioners are required to notify the Fund Office** in writing of any and all unauthorized employment within fifteen (15) days of beginning such employment.

Notification of termination of unauthorized employment: **Pensioners are required to notify the Fund Office** in writing of the termination of their unauthorized employment.

Resumption of benefits: The payments of your pension benefits may be resumed upon your notification to the Fund Office that you have terminated unauthorized employment.

Additional benefit credit: You may be entitled to additional benefit credit based on your covered employment after retirement – regardless of the number of days you worked during any one month. The determination of whether or not you qualify for additional benefit credit will be made after you terminate your covered employment. If you qualify for additional benefit credit, the amount of your pension benefit will be increased based on the credit you earned during your employment after retirement.
